Casa Los Zamorano is a cultural management project that establishes several parallel working lines: guided visits to the house and its heritage environment, the exposed speech spread using didactic manuals, the reception of temporary and travelling exhibitions and the objects collection preventive maintenance. Furthermore, it aspires to be an inherited archive, result of research, documentation, digitization, interviews, organization of cultural events and collaboration with other institutions and groups, involved in the conservation of ethnographic heritage.

Casa Los Zamorano participates in this way in the disclosure of the popular culture, in order to achieve its conservation and enhancement as awareness of visitors. Thus, the Zamorano's is planned as a place socially engaged with the preservation of the collective memory.

The *Interpretation Centre Casa Los Zamorano* opens its doors on June 28, 2013.

The rural character that even today, characterizes and defines Tegueste's landscape and people, becomes the central issue of the exhibition speech. We show a range of values that remain, are developed and progress to a context in which agriculture and traditional imagery, still identifies the community.

In this project, Tegueste's people have played a key role, providing valuable information for the speech documentation, and participating in the exhibition itself with their testimonies, photographs, donating objects and creating pieces. These aspects are decisive in establishing the criteria to follow in what we consider as ethnographic and folk heritage as the members of the community are who transmit what belongs and defines its cultural heritage.



1. Reception

Casa Los Zamorano was the home of the sharecroppers family of the adjacent farm in the 20th century.



2. The canarian wrestling in Tegueste

This vernacular sport has a long tradition in the community and it's still practiced today.



3. Festive Symbols

The Librea with the Dance of Flowers, the Ships, the Militia, and the Decorated Carts, colour the festivities.



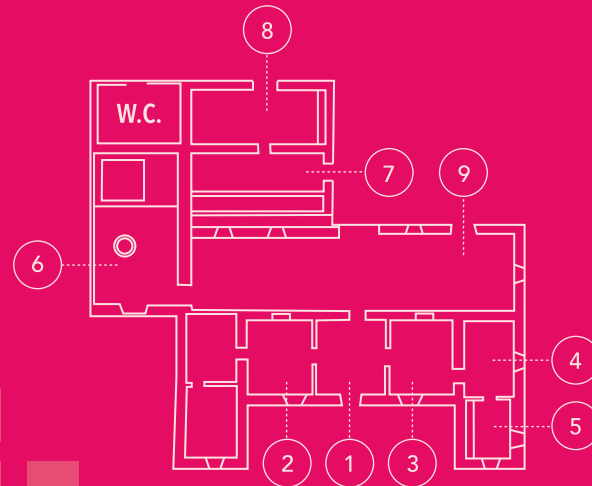
4. The agrifood heritage
